Irrigation Control via Rainbird Installation

Software Background:

Energy Management is the second largest budget in a school district, second only to personnel. Within that budget, electricity accounts for the majority: approximately 80%. Until recent years, water was considered to be the utility we worried about the least, thus it was used freely and without consequence. Because it was cheap, we developed bad habits and became "wasteful" in our everyday use of water. As we watch the cost of water rise steeply, now more than ever, we must find ways to identify and address our wasteful ways. The 2 consecutive tables below represent total water cost and cost/ft² for each fiscal year since 2007. Fiscal year 19-20 was a particularly odd year for obvious reasons, but Klein also shifted their fiscal year from Sept-Aug to July-June. This produced a 10-month fiscal year of Sept 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020.

Although Klein ISD is very conservative in its scheduling of HVAC and lighting, we view irrigation control as one way to address the increasing cost of water. Ensuring that we have a system in place that works, a process that everyone understands, and a means to address identified issues will allow us to increase our conservation efforts.

How are we using the available data to address issues?

Klein ISD uses Energy Manager Software to track water usage and cost, as well as energy usage and cost. Most campuses in Klein ISD do not have separate irrigation meters, and many campuses share meters with other campuses. Overall water usage and cost, by campus, can be found in the appendix of this report. The chart below, derived from Energy Manager Software, represents irrigation usage for the past 3 fiscal years for 3 participating campuses that benefitted from the grant.

Clearly, we can see that Ulrich Intermediate has extremely high usage as compared to both Krimmel Intermediate as well as Klein High School. At this point, we have the opportunity to view the schedule and begin to identify where the problem could be:



By looking at this schedule, we are certain that the high usage is not due to a leak, but instead scheduling. According to the available report in the Rainbird system, Ulrich Intermediate has used 192,595 gallons between 2/24 and 3/23/2021 (6,420 GPD or the equivalent of running 2.5 hours daily). Based on the system, these were scheduled and not manual run times.



A meeting was held on Wednesday, March 24th to discuss what needs to be done to address this. During this meeting between Energy Management and the supervisors of Environmental Quality, Athletics Grounds, and Irrigation, we determined that we needed to purchase hydrometers in order to determine if/when fields need to be watered rather than assuming that a brown patch signifies the need for additional water. Using tools that measure soil moisture, we'll be able to more quickly and accurately identify and respond to the coaches' needs on the field.

We are continuing to work with Environmental Quality, Athletic Grounds, and Irrigation, as well as the Director of Athletics and coaches to develop a "default" schedule for each Intermediate and High School. We will also be working collaboratively to develop and communicate a schedule regarding aerating, seeding, and fertilizing the fields. This has been an obstacle for us as we have simply been doing as the coaches request. Adding days and increasing run times without evidence of lack of water was the factor that was causing the reported issue. We will now be working directly with our representatives from Rainbird, Calsense, and Hydropint to gain knowledge and use tools to measure soil moisture.

It is important that processes be in place to ensure that everyone understands the critical need to find the balance between producing and maintaining healthy fields while conserving water. The diagram below represents the process which Klein ISD is beginning to implement:




Since the completion of the project, we have seen a decrease in the irrigation. However, it should be noted that the system was installed at the hottest time of the year and when fields are being well-maintained for upcoming sports practices. We will continue to monitor irrigation closely as we approach summer and throughout.




